BUILDING AND PARK ASPECTS

Main building: frame in cedar wood; with a restaurant sitting 70 people, outdoor terrace sitting 120, ticket booth, Boutique, and offices.

2 Parking lots:

- Cars: 350 spaces

- Buses: 50 spaces including a cleaning space

- Motorcycles: 35 spaces

- Main Picnic area: wooden environment with an outside fireplace made of fieldstones and 17 picnic tables. Practical for reunions or special events.
- Theater: cedar log building ideal for reunions and meeting place. For 120 people sitting or 200 people standing. Tables and chairs available.
- 5 Access road: paved road and footpaths dotted with giant animal sculptures along the walk.
- Secondary picnic area: tables and shelter. Unique view of the river. Ideal for small groups.
- Footpath: wooden levels, stairs, and viewpoints. Secure fencing and identification all along the trails with benches allowing you to rest and appreciate the environment. Interpretation panels in 6 languages. 1 km approx.
- Stone Stories Treasure Hunt: 0,6 km (0,4 miles). Interactive terminals, sculpture and different installations referring to myths and legends of the world. Relaxing spaces with gazebo.
- 9 Shuttle: Small vehicle sitting 7, reserved for our reduced mobility visitors.
- AirCANYON: Double-chair motorized ride flying above the abyss at 90 m high (300'), at a speed of 50km/h (31 mph) and at 396 m (1300')!



PATHS AND BRIDGES

Trails are 3-6 m wide (10-20') and have the capacity of 1500 people/hour.

North shore trails description:

Pont Mestachibo 60 meters long and 6 meters high (200' long and 20' high). Thoreau House. Recycled pavement or small gravel trail. Viewpoints overlooking the waterfall, the Giant Pothole (kettle) (15m / 50') and the rainbows. Access point to the adventures activities.

South shore trails description:

Pont McNicoll 50 meters long and 60 meters high (165' long and 200' high). Recycled or gravel trails, wooden level stairs and flats and lookout point overlooking the waterfall, rainbows and the 15 m diameter Giant Pothole (50').

Bottom of the gorge:

Access to the Laurent Bridge via a wooden stairway of 187 stairs. Metal bridge of 34 m in length and 11 m high (110' long and 36' high). 32m² observation area (350SF) with a bottom view of the Canyon, the suspension bridges, the waterfall, and the Mini Canyon.
